The following article is taken with permission from a correspondence Jim recently had via email.

Brother Jim,

I've been reading and studying some Scripture lately that worries and scares me to death:

1. Any of you who does not give up everything he has cannot be my disciple (Luke 14:33)

2. If anyone comes to me and does not hate his own life, he cannot be my disciple. (Luke 14:25)

3. Make every effort to enter through the narrow gate because many, I tell you, will try to enter in and will not be able to. (Luke 13:23)

4. Anyone who loves his father...["spouse" also?...]more than me is not worthy of me, and everyone who does take up his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. (Matthew 10:37)

5. Narrow is the road that leads to life and only a few find it. (Matthew 7:14)

I agree with you that these are serious and scary verses of scripture. If you look closely, you will also notice that they were all spoken by Jesus Himself. The one thing that has helped me try to interpret what Jesus was saying has been to look at the whole of scrip-

ture to see how to interpret His words here. As you know, salvation comes only by faith in Jesus alone, and not by anything we do. (Ephesians 2:8-9) (Romans 10:8-13) So, what was Jesus saying? Well, the key is to look at to whom He is speaking. Remember, Jesus came to a nation that had put their faith in their ancestry and a religious system. He was speaking truth, but so as to awaken them from their comfortable stupor. They thought they were okay with God, but they were far from Him. (Matthew 15:8-9) Jesus' words were spoken to shock them into dealing with the truth of who He was. Once they came to know who He was, and what the Truth was, the Truth would set them FREE. (John 8:31-32) Scripture goes on to say that it is *God* who works in and through those who come into a saving relationship with Jesus through faith. (Philippians 2:13) (Philippians 1:6) (Jude 24-25) So in summation, these words of Jesus are true and scary, but impossible for us to do apart from Him. (John 15:5) My prayer for you is that your faith in Jesus is not resting one bit in what

you do or don't do, or whether you are doing it well enough. My prayer for you is that you will rest completely in what Jesus has promised He will do in the lives of those that are His. All we need to do to be one of His children is to simply believe that He is who He is, and in what He has done, and trust Him to accomplish His plan for us in His time. That is total faith. That is giving up everything. That is hating our lives. That is entering through the narrow gate (Jesus). That is loving Jesus more than anyone else. That is the road that leads to life. Be one that finds it and looks completely to Jesus. Stop over-examining your efforts. Scripture teaches us to examine ourselves in 2 Corinthians 13:5. In this verse we are to examine ourselves to see whether Jesus is in us or not. Once we know that He is, we trust Him to finish His saving work in our lives. I hope this helps you my friend.
